Clermont State School will receive:

\$79,884*

This funding will be used to

- Enhance whole school positive behaviour with targeted initiatives to maintain the decreased number of Student Disciplinary Absences (SDAs) and continue to decrease negative behavioural referrals across the year.
- 95% of students achieve C or better in English end of semester reporting.
- 100% teaching staff document unit planning that aligns to documented planning flowchart and is submitted by week two each term.
- 100% of teaching staff actively engage in the four stages of moderation processes (internal and external) across a range of learning areas.

Our initiatives include

- Implement Positive Behaviour for Learning (PBL) as a whole-school framework to promote positive behaviour across a school and develop safe, supportive, conducive learning environments.
- Embed whole school moderation processes across all learning areas (including before moderation phase to support planning and data analysis).
- Develop staff capability in implementing the Literacy Continuum to track student progress and support the teaching of reading.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

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| Implement Positive Behaviour for Learning, supported by school-based mentor (Wellbeing Support Teacher) to implement behavioural classroom profiling and lead PBL Committee to shape the strategic schoolwide actions. | \$ 75,000.00 |
| Employing additional teacher to support classrooms (up to 1.0FTE). | \$ 25,000.00 |
| Release of whole year level teaching staff for curriculum planning (aligned to moderation phases) to ensure alignment across the year cohorts and to reduce variability between classroom content. | \$ 21,655.00 |
